I received a call from Dave Heath of Bannock Paving Co today in response to the curtailment letter. Bannock Paving is the holding company of Jack Parson. I gave Heath the background on curtailment and advised that they need to join the ground water district or possibly the processors group (I encouraged joining the GWD). I also advised that this use and the former license 36-7470 does not have an SRBA claim filed and thus IDWR pretty much considers that this right is no longer valid and that the use is not covered by a right. I advised that he may still be able to file a late claim in the SRBA. Heath said he will hire a water attorney to pursue getting the claim filed and petition to join the GWD or processors group.

Cindy and Corbin,
I noticed from review of WMIS that we have no reported water use information for this diversion for the last few years. Do we also have a reporting problem here or has the information just not been added to WMIS yet?
