Re: Minutes of the 2008 Goose Creek Water District 45-C annual meeting

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 pm mst on March 3, 2008 at the Oakley Canal Co. office in Oakley, Idaho. The meeting was called to order by secretary Kelly Adams. The following members were present: Michael Poulton, Karl (Bud) Bedke, Will Bedke, Brandon Bedke, and Carl Austin. There was not a representative from IDWR at this meeting. It would be helpful that a representative from IDWR attend regularly attend these annual meetings.

The first item of business was the appointment of officers. The method of voting used was by the majority vote of the water users present at the meeting. (Section 4, statute 42-605). Nominations were then conducted and Kelly Adams was re-appointed district secretary for the water year 2008. The minutes of the annual meeting for the water year 2007 were read and approved as written.

The budget was approved and it was noted that since no money is collected, the need for a budget is not required. The same conditions apply to not appointing a treasurer. A motion that the same resolutions adopted in 2007 be adopted for water year 2008. This was accepted. A nomination for water-master was held and Michael Poulton was elected water-master and serves under the same terms and conditions as did the previous water-master.

Other items of business- 1) should have an adequate supply of water, 2) district 45-C is not subject to the terms and conditions of the new water district 140.

The secretary requests from IDWR - 1) a current water-master handbook, 2) a copy of the water-master oath to be administered to Mr. Poulton and 3) a copy of the water-master's annual report forms. Thank you.
