MINUTES OF WATER DISTRICT 43C HELD JANUARY 28,2006 RAFT RIVER ELECTRIC BOARD ROOM MALTA, IDAHO

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 12:05 P.M. BY CHAIRMAN PAUL WARD. FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS TO APPOINT A CHAIRMAN. BILL WICKEL NOMINATED PAUL WARD. LARRY KINCADE SECONDED THE NOMINATION. THERE WERE NO OTHER NOMINATIONS. VOTING WAS UNANIMOUS.

MAXEEN WARD WAS SELECTED TO REMAIN AS SECRETARY.

BILL WICKEL MADE A MOTION THAT WE MAINTAIN THE THE SAME ADVISORY COMMITTEE AS FOR 2005. JACK WIGHT SECONDED THAT MOTION. THOSE ON THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ARE TOM OTTLEY, STAN LLOYD AND TED HIGLEY.

MINUTES FOR THE 2005 MEETING WERE READ BY THE SECRETARY. TOM HUTCHISON MOTIONED THAT THE MINUTES BE APPROVED AS READ AND NOEL BOWCUT SECONDED THAT MOTION.

SELECTION OF WATERMASTER. BILL LOUGHMILLER NOMINATED ROGER MUSSER FOR THE JOB OF WATER MASTER AND NOEL BOWCUT SECONDED THE NOMINATION. THERE WERE NO OTHER NOMINATIONS.ROGER MUSSER WILL BE THE WATERMASTER FOR THE 2006 WATER SEASON.

ROGER MUSSER BROUGHT UP THAT THERE MANY PLACES WITH DIVERSION POINTS THAT ARE IN BAD CONDITION. SOME PLACES HE HAS TO ESTIMATE HOW MUCH WATER IS USED SOME TROUBLE SPOTS ARE THE GREEN CANYON DIVERSION POINT, UPPER HEADGATE ON RAMONA SEARS PLACE, ON THE OLD HEPWORTH PLACE, SIMPLOTS THE BARKER DITCH., NYE'S PLACE AND MORANVILLE'S

CHARLIE WARD SAID A WOOD WEIR WORKS WELL, IS EASY TO SETAND FAIRLY INEPENSIVE.MEASURING DEVICES SHOULD BE PUT IN AT THE WATER USERS EXPENSE.

TOM HUTCHISON MADE A MOTION THAT THE ADVSORY BOARD IDENTIFY THE PROBLEMS ALONG WITH THE WATER MASTER AND FILL OUT AND SUBMIT THE PAPER WORK TO THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES.
