WAGES FOR WATER MASTER AND SECRETARY/TREASURER

Water Master will be paid \$300 at the beginning of the irrigation season and \$600 at the end of the season after the "Water Master's Report" is turned in. The Secretary/Treasurer is to be paid \$75.00 for the year. Motion made by Larry Kelsey with a second by Ralph Sleight. All voted in favor.

RESOLUTION C

\$3000 will be assessed now and the Advisory committee along with the Chairman will decide during the year if the remaining \$2000 of the budget will need to be assessed. There will be a \$20 charge assessed to each entity in the water district with the remaining being assessed according to water usage. Motion made by Roy Bunderson with a second by Don Nye. All voted in favor.

RESOLUTION D

Be it resolved: That no ditch, canal company, or other water user, shall have the right to demand and receive water, and the water master shall not deliver to such person until the amount due and payable from such user, as fixed by the budget, has been paid. Richard Stocker made the motion with a second from Larry Kelsey. All voted in favor.

WATER MASTER

Jeremiah Mattson will be the water master. Motion made by Larry Kelsey with a second by David Matthews. All voted in favor.


