Re: Appointment as Watermaster of Water District 140

Dear Brian:

Congratulations on being elected and appointed as Watermaster for Water District 140. I am sure your professional attributes will be demonstrated in the accurate delivery of water and diplomatic interaction with the water users.

Prior to your appointment, you signed an oath to perform watermaster duties as described in Idaho Code §§ 42-605 and 42-607. In essence, you are an extension of the Department of Water Resources, and are bound by similar obligations as an employee of the Department to perform the watermaster duties, as instructed by the Department, to the exclusion of any other water related interests you may have. Principles of ethical behavior demand that you avoid direct conflicts of interest and the appearance of conflicts.

As discussed at the special meeting for Water District 140, conducted on March 16, 2010, the following are expectations to insure adherence to ethical principles:

- 1. All water measurement and reporting performed by the watermaster must be for all the water users as a whole and compensation for such work must be solely derived from the assessments to the users according to the methods of assessment described in Chapter 6, Title 42 of the Idaho Code. All contracts you hold or previously held for measurement and reporting for individuals and entities within the water district must become a part of the general obligation of the watermaster.
- 2. A watermaster should not prepare mitigation plans, applications for new water rights or transfers, or any other applications or proposals for individual water users or water use entities within the water district. In addition, a watermaster should not be an advocate to the Department or in any other forum for particular water users within the water district or in any matter that would affect a water user negatively or positively within the water district. Nonetheless, a watermaster is required to recommend a course of action for the Department. Furthermore, water users and the watermaster should be able to freely discuss proposals, and the watermaster should be able to discuss these proposals with Department staff.

3. Any other contracts that would relate to the watermaster's responsibility to administer and regulate water rights within the district should be strictly avoided. When any question arises about a possible conflict, I encourage you to visit with Department staff about the matter before engaging in the activity.

I look forward to your upcoming service as a watermaster.
