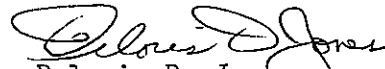

1. Election of Chairman + BofD

Lynn read list of current members. Frank Erwin said Dan McFadden would like to be replaced. There is no limit or minimum to the number of members needed on the Board.

- Bryan Kenworthy said their springs are still declining but not as steeply as in the past.

## 5. Budget

Frank handed out the past and proposed budgets. He didn't anticipate any changes needing funding. He is not proposing assessments for 2009. Assessment may be needed in 2010 depending on events this year. Frank said if diesel prices remain low, he can handle his auto costs.

#### 6 Other Business.

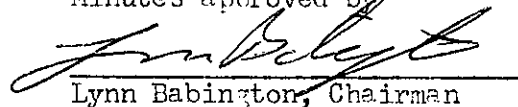
