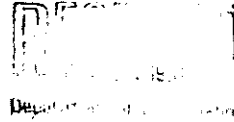

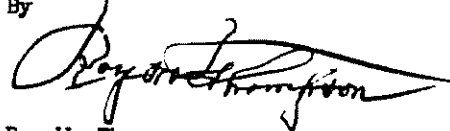

Dear Mr. Leaton:

We are in receipt of two (2) complaints in connection with the distribution of the water of Carmen Creek. One complaint by Mr. John Austin, and the other by Mr. John Austin, Jr., who has bought the McCracken place. The complaints state that they are not getting their full amount of water as called for by the decrees.

It is not possible for the writer to be in your vicinity this week. However, will try to be there some time next week, at the request of the Austins.

In the meantime we wish that you would see that the Austins' rights are filled, according to the priority of their decreed rights, if the supply of water in Carmen Creek is sufficient to supply said rights.

The complaint of Mr. John Austin states that you are delivering additional water to rights on the stream with later priorities than the water rights of the Austins.

Kindly report to this department immediately regarding water distribution on Carmen Creek.

Relative to the delivery of domestic water, the watermaster has no authority from this department to deliver to any water user domestic water when the water user is an owner of a decreed water right. In other words, the waters of Carmen Creek are to be distributed according to the decreed right only.

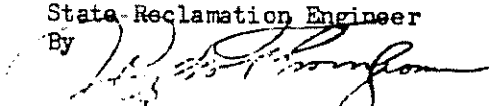

Relative to the agreement entered into between the Carmen Creek people and the Big Flat people filed as of the 20th day of June, 1900.

We are enclosing a photo-copy of this agreement which was obtained last fall from the county auditor at Salmon. We also enclose a photo-copy of the referee's decision for your guidance.

As far as we can determine or as far as the referee's report states, they made no determination as to the distribution of the amount of water saved to Carmen Creek by the construction of the Salmon River Ditch and diversion.

Provided there is no additional record in the court house preceding the enclosed agreement, the waters saved by the construction of the Salmon River Ditch will have to be distributed to all the water users of Carmen Creek and not to any certain individual water user, as has been done in the past.

Until a future settlement is produced by court action or otherwise, you are hereby instructed to deliver the waters of Carmen Creek according to the decree entitled David McNutt, et al., vs. Thomas Palmer, et al.

With the exclusion of the rights now receiving water from Salmon River, we believe the water users of Carmen Creek that have been receiving certain amounts of the saved water by the construction of the Salmon River ditch will have objection to this order. So if you will take the matter up with them, they in all probability, will wish to take some future action in the matter.
