

And said David McNutt is hereby ordered and directed to convey to defendants and cross-complaints his might to the use of said 200 inches of the waters of said creek, in accordance with the terms of said contract and the findings and report of James ". Hockensmith, Phomas Pyeatt and William Peterben, referees, on file herein."

Hockensmith, Thomas Pyeatt and William Peterson referees, on file herein."
