**Water Master's 2009
Annual Report**

I would like to thank all of the Water District Members as a whole for the overall cooperation on the call of water during this last irrigation season. We did work as a team when it counted. Everybody did there part.

Overall projection for the season was **6024.44 CFS** and our actual usage of water total was **7932.74 CFS**, a difference of 1908.3 CFS to our good. This amounted to 131.68%. Therefore, the cost to the user was \$.78 a share less. Our members did utilize water earlier, getting the ground moisture up

Rains came at the right time, extending water into the irrigation season an estimated 2 ½ to 3 weeks longer. It especially showed up on the Howell Creek drainage. I did have to call for the complete first right at the head of Howell Creek this year on August 28th and returned it all back by the 12 October. I might also indicate that the other factor for extending the water season for the Fourth Year in a row is the Rock Dam Reservoir, which the water district has profited from.

It will be noted that some of the springs did supply water this year over the previous year's that had dried up! Most of the springs along the whole mountain frontage of the Water District have yet to reestablish. Amos Creek again ran all season (estimated 1.20cfs max to .35cfs min). Summit Creek extended its self way into the season therefore, extending those users on Howell Creek.

Most of the decreed users have resolved their problems with their delivery systems and have implemented them by this last fall. I thank those of you for that. We still have a few diehards with diversion and measuring devices that are not in line legally, who have yet to adhere or comply too the water districts request in the extension given by the board in our last meeting. We need those diversions corrected so delivery of water can be measured correctly and not estimated. See List below.

Additional Action Items:

It will be noted that there are four rectangular weirs that were placed in operation, that need modified to a height of an additional 4 to 6 inches to qualify as a proper weir. Those Diversions are 6S/White Pine and 'LB1'. Also, the two (2) resent ones that Leroy Robinson placed in service in 2009 need to be wider and set deeper for proper flow.

I am requesting as your current Water Master, action from this delegation today on the following:

1. We need a clarification from the Watermaster of 140 as too the specific type of Flow-meter that is required for the deep wells. I have received a inquire from one of the Deep Well users that he had a system that could of cost him a 3rd of the price of what he was told he had to go with (Seametric Magnetic Flow Meter AG2000)! Also the type of flow-meter to best measure an inline flow on a closed system (surface).

2. Pomerelle Ski Resort to be in place with all their changes with measuring devices dealing with the snowmaking and ponds under the Adjudicated Water rights that were presented to the MCWD and Watermaster 45F by the beginning of the 2010 Ski season. Also, requiring a flow meter at the Bennett Springs pumping station.
 - a. It will be noted that Pomerelle Ski Resort did have in place their first pond in above the Lodge and was inspected by the water master, IDWR and was approved with a little reluctance from the U.S. Forest Dept. due to some of their lease agreement requirements.
3. *As your Watermaster on Feb. 16th, I placed Earl Warthen's name in for nomination to represent MCWD45F at all meetings with Water District 140 dealing in the Ground Water Exercise and the City of Albion (representative) in the place of alternate. I believe the two should work together so they are abreast of what is going on. Also,*
4. *The members of the Water District 45F to continue with considering using the Water District No. 140 staff in certifying the wells since the cost is too great for our water district. But to include the regular reading and posting, generating annual reports for the state to the Watermaster of 45F, thus eliminating excessive undue cost. The Watermaster would not be charging the hourly rate that Water District No. 140 would charge.*

Those in violation as of this water meeting are:

- Antone/Pine Creek; Grant Clark and Fred Hawker
 - This is still an ongoing situation.
The main channel at 1st diversion point Grant Clark (Antone), a diversion screw down head gate needs to be placed with a measuring device(s), needs to be installed. A 2nd diversion placed where Fred Hawker diverts his water with a measuring device(s) head gate needs to also be installed. I have submitted this problem since 2000.
- Howell Creek Halard Diversion & weir; Albion Ranch 2006 LLC
 - Note: Hallowed Weir and Diversion was destroyed sometime between the end of irrigation 2006 and the beginning of 2007 irrigation (March 13th the watermaster in turning water out for the Bells found this problem) season. Turned it into the Dept. of Water Resources at that time,
 - Cindy Yenter and I reviewed the problem and Cindy sent a letter out on behalf of IDWR that they needed to replace the system back for the delivery of the water. Albion Ranch either maintains the lateral or the user, Lee Jolley. I have yet to get a report from them. Therefore, I feel it's the responsibility of the Marsh Creek Water District to enforce the law and get this matter corrected.
- Howell Creek Diversion 'HC1': Albion Ranch needs to place flow-meters into the enclosed delivery system.
- Howell Creek Diversions at Norm Dayley's East & West delivery systems (measuring devices)
- Mathews change of Diversion (transfer) and diversion, weir & measuring device
 - 'HK' Diversion, this needs to be checked out and work done with it. Mathews is talking about utilizing 'HI' diversion, has been okayed, by the other parties on the

delivery system, but will require a change of diversion and compliance with a measuring device.

- Warm Creek; Chatburn Ranch
- Howell Creek Sub-division Diversion weir and measuring device (this is in the process of the sub-division's development).
- Marsh Creek "West-slope" Laterals; Geary Ranch and Anderson Ranch
- March Creek Diversion 'ME1" needs the screw down head-gate repaired (shaft bent) responsibility both Geary & Anderson Ranch's
- Marsh Creek 'MG1' Montgomery head-gate & measuring device for separate lateral
- Marsh Creek off of Cooper/Montgomery's lateral a measuring and diversion required both Montgomery and Shawn Mia.
- Marsh Creek 'MI1' Lateral (Vaughn Ditch) diversion & measuring devices for both Nick Knudson and Steve Langer are required.
- Vaughn Ditch lateral head-gate to Kevin Banner, still in need of repair (closing off the V-notch in base of device).
- Cooper Ranch, Div off of Vaughn lateral needs a measuring device and cleanup of weir.
- Marsh Creek diversion at 6s-Ben needs modified with a proper closed shield at inlet.
- Land Creek User's on Berrett Ditch needs to get diversions in place. They are: Shirley Clark, Alan Clark, Don Gunderson, GVW Ranch & Geo Kelley.
- Starrh Ditch diversion on lateral of the 309/317 user's. Those parties are all responsible in maintaining this diversion with measuring devices.
- Patkin Idaho LLC Weir:
- Unnamed Creek; Kempton/Brackenbury weir and measuring device.

Land Creek Channel:

It will be noted that George Kelley is in the process of creating a separate diversion system off of Diversion "LF", he plans to have it enclosed all the way to his point of use. The deliver system would be setup through the 6S Emory Ranch (South meadows) going east and cutting across the Ina Droz northwest piece of property to 1000 South.

- A) The "LI" Diversion. The weir is in place but there is no Head gate. It is setup with sliding boards. Needs screw-down plus a measuring device if diversion is to be used as a legal diversion. Mr. Roger Jenkins needs to open up delivery channel in which he has covered up after purchasing the ground from Cunningham. This is still an issue if Erickson is to use the system.
- B) It will be noted that the Cunningham Ranch was sold to Patkin Idaho LLC and the property was annex into the city of Albion for a new Sub-division.
- C) Again, same issue, the main channel only has one (1) legal diversion and measuring devices on the creek. Due to the adjudication changes, we have delivery of water to David Clark, 6S Ranch and Droz's (others (?)). Their needs to be legal measuring devices and head gates placed on this creek by the users if they are to call for water.
 - Note: David Clark has complied with Div-head-gate (screw-down) and measuring device at entry of his property.

Legal Pump Diversions in creek's:

- The Water District did indicate through Allen Merritt's ruling that if that water right is down to a portion of the right and it has to go to the next in line, it is shut off irregardless, if the individual persists to use a pump then there shall be a monitor required instead of guessing on usage.
 - As the Water-master, here are some following options that **SHALL** be implemented. 'ABB C-700 Water Meters vary from the Minimum of ¼ GPM to 25 GPM maximum (¾"size) to a 1" to 2" sizes that will deal in GPM from ¾ to 2 and max out respectively 25 to 50 GPM. See me for more information.

Point of Interest:

Six-S Ranch developed a new Reservoir during the 2004 season, completing the project in December 2004. The dam that was constructed is called "Point of Rocks Dam" was constructed to a height of 25+/- feet. The homogenous/zoned earth fill dam provides storage of 253 acre-feet for irrigation, recreation, and fish and wildlife propagation. Although originally designed as a thin core dam, the dam was constructed as a section dam with the upper 2/3 consisting of impervious material and the lower 1/3 of pervious material. The irrigation project services an area consisting of 1,541 irrigable acres under existing distribution systems from Marsh Creek.

The last two seasons, 6S-Ranch's two sediment catch basins (with the following dimensions (225' long, 10' deep, 60' wide) were constructed immediately adjacent to Marsh Creek and 6S-Ranch's property in the SENW of Section 22, Township 11 South, Range 25 East, Cassia County. Only one basin will be in use per season. When the first basin is full of sediment, water will then be diverted into the second basin. Water will be diverted into the sediment catch basin and then immediately returned to Marsh Creek. The purpose of these catch basins is to substantially reduce the amount of sediment and debris in Marsh Creek, thereby improving its water quality. It will be noted that this is working very well and will keep from filling the Reservoir with silt
