of season.**

Watermaster. seconded by Leland  
Motion Passed**

**Leland stated that Garden Creek Incorporation paper work  
has been sent in.**

**Advisory Committee: Brian Made motion that the advisory  
committee stay the same which is the elected officers and  
the watermaster. seconded by Klain  
Motion passed.**

transfer a point of diversion of a right in order to pump out of
