Upon receipt of your Oath of Office, and a petition signed by at least three waterusers asking that you assume your duties, your Certificate of Appointment will be issued. A petition is not required if your duties are on an annual basis.

Enclosed are an Oath of Office form, and if needed, a Petition form for calling the watermaster to duty.

BE SURE TO SEE THAT THE "PETITION FOR WATERMASTER'S SERVICES" IS FILED WITH THE DEPARTMENT AND YOUR FORMAL INSTRUCTIONS ISSUED BEFORE YOU ASSUME YOUR DUTIES.

You should also note that the enclosed certificate of appointment authorizes delivery of natural flow water only. Before you can deliver stored water you must be appointed Special Deputy by the Director pursuant to Section 42-801, IDAHO CODE.

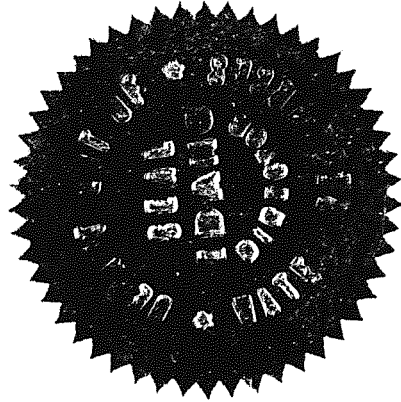
