

Annual Meeting
Twin Lakes Water District 95-C
March 17, 2003
Twinlow Camp, Twin Lakes, Idaho

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by the President, Diane Park.

12 people attended the meeting.

The minutes for the 2002 meeting were read. A motion to approve the minutes was made and seconded. The motion was carried.

Reports for 2002-2003:

Treasurer: Susan Park gave the financial report for 2002-2003.

Balance on hand March 16, 2002	\$23,559.25
Balance on hand March 15, 2003	\$28,101.06

See attached Income Statement for income and expense accounting.

Susan Park reported that our balance in checking was 8,795.55 and 19,305.52 in the Local Government Investment Pool.

Correspondence: Correspondence received for the year were normal bills and statements.

Water Master: Dan Park reported he was not activated during the 2002-2003 season and that no problems were reported by water right holders.

Snow Survey Report: Chet Park reported that the snow pack was 50-60% of average for mid March. The ground under the snow at Ragged Mountain and East Ragged Saddle were frozen and the ground at Twin Spirit Divide was not frozen and dry. He reported that there could be higher elevation rapid spring runoff, moderated by soaking into lower elevation dry soil.

He recommended filling the lake gradually over the remainder of March and that since it looked like it was going to be a dry year, we should keep the lake level as high as possible.

Old Business:

Gordon Sylte reported that clay had been delivered and was ready to fill holes. We need to get in put into the holes. Problem areas include the lower part of Hogan's and Willadsen's. There was discussion of using a Bobcat for putting the clay into the creek possibly in late May or early June and getting work release prisoners out to help with this.

New Business:

Budget for 2003: Susan Park presented the proposed budget for the fiscal year. The proposed budget was the same as last year. The budget was discussed and a motion was made by Chuck Kinsey and was seconded by Gordon Sylte to adopt the proposed budget of \$6,000 for the fiscal year, 2003-2004. Motion was carried.

The need for monitoring of snow pack levels was discussed and Chet Park volunteered to research the cost of the equipment for a Snow Tell site (equipment for automated measurement of snow pack)

The Twin Lakes Dam Replacement Project, the upcoming bond election and future purchase of water measuring devices by the water district for the new dam were discussed. The bond election will be held May 27, 2003 and after it is approved, we will need move forward with the purchase of water measuring devices.

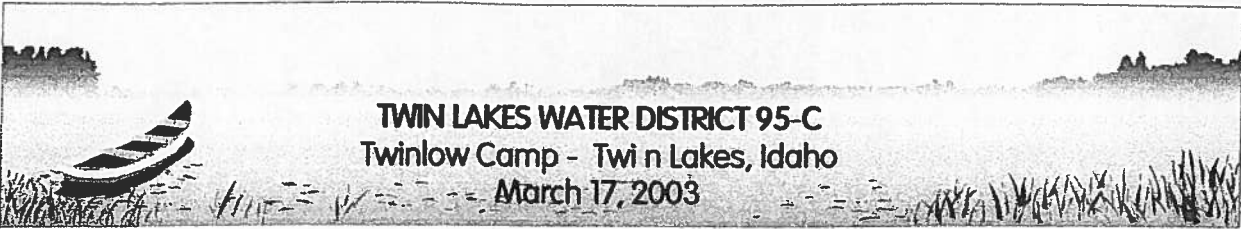

Snow Pack
Twin Lakes Drainage Basin
As of March 15, 2003

Here are my measurements for March 15, 2003, for the Twin Lakes drainage basin:

Ragged Mountain: (Mid March averages 54 inches with 21 swe)

26.4 inches snow; 10.5 SWE (snow water equivalent); 40% moisture content

East Ragged Saddle: (Mid March averages 53 inches with 21 swe)

21.3 inches; 9.9 SWE; 46%

Twin Spirit Divide: (Mid March averages 39 inches with 13 swe)

11.3 inches; 4.7 SWE; 42%

All are less than half of average.

Ground under snow at Ragged and East Ragged Saddle is frozen. Ground is not frozen and dry at Twin Spirit Divide. Possible higher elevation rapid spring runoff but moderated by soaking into lower elevation dry soil.

I recommend filling the lake gradually in the next two to three weeks. I do not see much additional runoff occurring. Streams appear to be at normal flow levels and the snow is melting somewhat rapidly.
