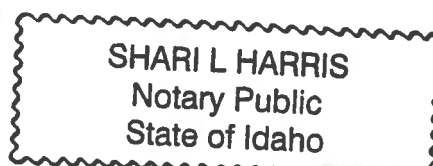

TWINLOW CAMP, TWIN LAKES IDAHO
MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Don Ellis at 7:00 pm. The minutes of the May 19, 2011 annual meeting were approved as written. (Moved by Mike McKinlay, seconded by Dan Park). The treasurer's report (attached income statement) was presented by Treasurer Sue Park. It was approved, as presented.

Watermaster Laurin Scarcello gave the watermaster's report (attached). Dan Park moved that we accept the report. Barbara Swehosky and Diane Park seconded the motion and it was passed. Compensation of the watermaster was then discussed. The Chair entertained a motion that would compensate Laurin for the 3.5 hours worked at \$20. Megan McKinlay so moved, Debra Andrews seconded. Motion passed.

Advisory Committee – Dan Park, Megan McKinlay and Diane Park were nominated and elected by a unanimous ballot. (Moved by Debra Andrews, seconded by Mike McKinlay).

The budget (attached) was presented by Treasurer Sue Park/Watermaster Laurin Scarcello. The total tax assessment amount was to be lowered again this year – to \$250. The budget was amended to keep the tax assessment at \$500. It was moved by Diane Park and seconded by Barb Swehosky that we accept the amended budget. Motion passed.

Elections – The following slate of officers was nominated, then elected by a unanimous ballot: Don Ellis – chairman, Susie Ellis – secretary, Sue Park – treasurer, Laurin Scarcello – watermaster, and Dan Park – assistant watermaster.

Other Business – The lake is full (10.38), the creek is full. The goal is to keep it full. We have 21" of snow, which equals 8.2" of water above.

Gordon Sylte updated us on the Flood Control District. We owe \$109,000. It will be paid off in 2-3 years. The FCD has a \$12,000. to \$15,000. project coming up.

North Idaho Adjudication – They are continuing to process the applications that they have received. 10,400 applications so far. Our basin was notified Nov. 16, 2011. The final report is expected in 2016.

The next annual meeting will be the **second** Thursday in May 2013.

LAURIN SCARCELLO, WATERMASTER

I was called by Keith Franklin on 8/4/11 to be activated in regards to lack water flow from No Name Stream on to the Sylte property. John Sylte had concerns of lack of water coming into his pond, which is used to pump water for irrigation.

On 8/8/11 I met with Keith Franklin, Greg Taylor, Paul Finman, and Norm Semingco on Finman property to inspect No Name Stream. Prior to the meeting Keith and Greg went above Finman's land to verify flow coming into Finmans and Keith said flow appeared to be similar. No Name Stream flows through an old dam type structure on Finman property which is no longer maintained. The area nearby has been logged and brushed out as well as excavation was being done to allow for a structure to be built. A tributary flow was also present and verified by all flowing into No Name Stream. This spring flowed through and under what Norm called a bridge for an old maintenance road for the old dam. Even with timber removal, brush work and excavation there was continuous flow of water. To me the fact that someone would go through the effort to develop this stream years ago would suggest this was a viable source of water.

Paul stated there are numerous springs on his property and a artesian well that was drilled. Paul seemed aggravated and offered to build a pipe line to carry No Name Stream from property above him, through his land to Sylte's property line.

Syltes have a water right for more gallons per minute than No Name Stream is currently providing. No water should be diverted from No Name Stream or springs contributing to it to better serve Syltes water right. One would question if further ground disturbance or development should be allowed in close proximity of this area so No Name Stream is not encumbered.

In closing this water has obviously flowed and chosen this path for many years and should continue to do so despite property lines and property owners to better serve downstream users and needs.
