

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Don Ellis at 7:15 pm. The minutes of the May 10, 2012 annual meeting were approved as written. (Moved by Megan McKinlay, seconded by Dan Park). The treasurer's report (attached income statement) was presented by Treasurer Sue Park. It was approved, as presented.

Watermaster Laurin Scarcello gave the watermaster's report (attached). Gordon Sylte moved that we accept the report. Dan Park seconded the motion. Paul Finman wanted it noted that he challenged the report. The report was accepted unanimously.

Advisory Committee – Dan Park, Megan McKinlay and Diane Park were re-elected by a unanimous ballot. (Moved by Gordon Sylte and, seconded by Mike McKinlay).

The budget (attached) was presented by Treasurer Sue Park/Watermaster Laurin Scarcello. It was moved by Dan Park and seconded by Dian Park that we accept the budget. Motion passed.


Other Business – The lake is almost full (10.'). Outflow is just a trickle. We have no snowpack left. Water data is all on-line.

Firman at 9:00 A.M.

There was Minimal Flow out of John Syltes Pond.  
Minimal to No Flow From No Name Stream Entering  
The Pond. But Approx  $8\frac{1}{2}$  Gallon per min Above Firman Dam.  
No Name Stream Was Flowing Less than Half of Last  
years Visit.

At Old Concrete Dam on Firman Land Paul Agreed  
Dry Well That Diverts Flow to Creek. It was Discussed  
that This should Be Taken out Entirely.

Paul Agreed to Light maintenance (Hand Tools & Cleaning  
in No Name Stream Creek Bed to Enhance Flow.  
Keith was Permitted By Paul to Clean Screen For  
Outlet of Dam and Later to Take Screen Out  
To Allow For Better Flow For Sylte Water Right.

It is Agreed That Semco spring Flowing under  
Semco Bridge is Tributary to No Name Stream.  
It is Agreed That a Maintenance plan - Spring and

Fall clearing of Limbs, Pine Needle + Dead Fall would  
Benefit Natural Flow For All Party's concernal.  
Piping water and Solar Pumps were Discussed to  
Enhance Flow. Keith Suggested Natural Flow is Best.

Closing Thoughts - Perforated Steel Pipe in old  
Dam on Finman Land Should Be  
Removed so as to Not Divert Flow  
From No Name Stream.

Ground Disturbance on Finman Land  
Appears to Divert some spring Flow  
From No Name Stream. This Seems  
To Serve No purpose or Benefit to Paul  
And perhaps even would pose a problem For  
His New Buildings. If Ground was Brought  
Back to Natural State This spring Flow  
would Contribute to No Name Stream.
