The meeting was called to order by Chairman Don Ellis at 7:00 pm.

The minutes of the May 21, 2015 annual meeting, and the minutes of the July 9, 2015 special meeting, were approved as written.

The treasurer's report (attached income statement) was presented by Treasurer Sue Park. It was approved, as presented.

Watermaster Laurin Scarcello stated that there were a lot of calls and concerns this year. With permission of the landowners to cross their properties, 3000 pounds of bentonite were put on the creek bottom to facilitate water delivery to downstream users. More work needs to be done. Laurin recommended that we activate the watermaster immediately. (The advisory board did not meet this year).

The Flood District Report was made by board member Gordon Sylte. He spoke to the issues of the creek losing water and the work that Charlie Cramer had done to ameliorate the problem. Improvements were made where the creek goes through Miller, Hogan, and Finman's properties. The FCD has contacted the state about another snowtel site. Because of the expense, this will be a non- automated snowtel site. Gordon Stephenson, member of the FCD board, is working on this.

Morgan Case, the new regional director of IDWR, updated us on the North Idaho Adjudication. Basin 95 is getting closer. Notices will go out this fall. They are still accepting new water right claims

Water Data The lake is now at 10'3". It has been over the legal 10'4". Deb Andrews, President of Twin Lakes Improvement Association, reminded us that we need to remember the property owners on the lake as well and to not keep the water too high or too low. Sue Park said the trend already points to another low water year. We had more snowpack in April than last year, but it disappeared faster than normal.

OLD BUSINESS

Measuring inflow to Twin Lakes at Fish creek and other tributaries. Debbie Andrews: "In order to facilitate water delivery to downstream users, I move the Water District fund up to \$15,000., to be used at the discretion of the Water Advisory Board. The allocated money will be used to measure inflow into the lakes, as well as to install an inflow gauge on Fish Creek." Cheryl Knowlton seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Two spots have been tentatively picked: one on Easterday's and one on Inland Empire Paper's property.

NEW BUSINESS

Composition of the Water Advisory Board Bob Kuhn moved "the chairperson and the water master be standing members of the advisory board, in addition to the 3 regular advisory board members. The chairperson of the District will serve as the chair of the advisory board and call meetings as necessary. The secretary will attend the meeting, as a non-voting member, to take minutes of the proceedings." Denise Hogan seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The budget was presented by Treasurer Sue Park. The proposed budget, as amended, was approved. (The approved \$15,000. for inflow measurements was added. Creekbed maintenance was raised to \$4000. The tax assessment amount was raised to \$3,000.).

Elections – The following officers were nominated, then elected: Laurin Scarcello Watermaster, Dan Park Asst. Watermaster, Susie Ellis Secretary, and Sue Park Treasurer. Nominations were made for the Advisory Board. Voting was done by paper ballots. Colby Clark, Tom Pearson, and Doug Jayne were elected. Nominations for Chairperson and Vice Chairperson were made. Terry Kiefer was elected as Chairperson and Don Ellis as Vice Chairperson.

An advisory board meeting was set for Wed., June 8th at 7pm at the Rathdrum Library. (The time is NOW 6pm. Date TBD).

The next annual meeting will be the 11th, 18th, or 25th of May 2017.

The meeting was adjourned.
