MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING OF MARCH 11, 2014

In accordance with the provisions of the Idaho Code setting the date of the annual meeting for the Water District, the users of Water District 32-C met this day at 3:00 p.m. at the Clark County Annex Bldg. in Dubois, Idaho, for the purpose of electing a Watermaster, Chairman and Secretary, adopting a budget, fixing the salary of the Watermaster and Secretary, and transacting such other business that might come before the meeting pertaining to the irrigation water of the District.

Those in attendance were: Greg Shenton, Watermaster; Brett Murdock, Deputy Watermaster; Laurie Small, secretary; Brock Egan, Lynn Hoggan, Sid Brown, Kevin Small, Rhett Jacobs and Garth Ashcraft.

Chairman, Tod Shenton, called the meeting to order at 3:10 p.m.

Lynn Hoggan moved and Sid Brown seconded that the proposed agenda be adopted. The motion passed.

MINUTES:

Chairman Tod Shenton entertained a motion to approve the 2013 minutes. Brett Murdock pointed out an error made on the date above the adopted budget chart. The year needed to be changed from 2012 to 2013. Garth Ashcraft moved that the minutes be approved with change made. Brock Egan seconded the motion. Motion passed.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS:

Chairman Tod Shenton asked for nominations from the floor for the office of Chairman and Secretary. Sid Brown nominated Tod Shenton as Chairman. Garth Ashcraft seconded the nomination. The floor was open for any further discussion. Brock Egan moved that nominations cease. Rhett Jacobs seconded the motion. Nomination passed. Sid Brown nominated Laurie Small for secretary. Brock Egan seconded the nomination. The floor was open for any further discussion. Garth moved that nominations cease. Rhett Jacobs seconded. Nomination passed.

CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE:

Kevin Small made a motion to waive the appointing of the Credentials Committee unless needed at a later time. Garth Ashcraft seconded the motion. Motion passed.

WATERMASTER'S REPORT:

Deputy Watermaster Brett Murdock, discussed 2013 Water District 32-C Watermaster's report as follows.

2013 WATER YEAR:

The 2013 water delivery was 12,446 A.F. of water compared to 18,865 A.F. in the previous year (2012), a difference of 6,419 A.F. of water.

2013-14 SNOW COURSE MEASUREMENT:

Snow measurements at Irving Creek were 15" with 3.0 water content averaging 68% of normal. Weber Creek snow depth was 18" with 4.2 water content averaging 88% of normal. The average of the two creek drainages at 77% of normal. Measurement were taken February 28, 2014.

FINANCIAL REPORT AND BUDGET:

Deputy Watermaster Brett Murdock reviewed the 2013 budget, explaining some of the expenditures. Brett then presented the 2014 proposed budget. Brett reviewed the USGS measurements and the Medicine Lodge bed loss measurements with the water users.

There was additional discussion on the funds set aside to beaver.

Deputy Watermaster, Brett Murdock reviewed an addition that needed to be put in the resolutions on Headgates and Weirs to help take more precise measurements. It would read as follows: "All headgate systems that have return flow capability or bypass channel for the water to return to Medicine Lodge must have a weir installed and functioning before water will be delivered." This will be the landowners/water user responsibility.

Watermaster, Greg Shenton, gave a brief report on the cloud seeding in the area.

WATERMASTER'S REPORT & BUDGET APPROVAL:

Chairman Tod Shenton asked for a motion to approve the Watermaster's Report and proposed budget. Kevin Small made a motion to approve the Watermaster's Report and proposed budget. Garth Ashcraft seconded the motion. The floor was open for further discussion. Motion passed.

ELECTION OF WATERMASTER:

Chairman Tod Shenton asked for nominations for Watermaster. Rhett Jacobs made the motion Greg Shenton continue as Watermaster. Sid Brown seconded the motion. Brock Egan moved that all nominees leave the room during the voting process. Kevin Small seconded the motion. The floor was open to any further nominations. Sid Brown moved nominations cease. Brock Egan seconded the motion. Motions and nomination passed.

RESOLUTIONS:

Chairman Tod Shenton then asked the water users to adopt the following resolutions with the additional wording, discussed during the Watermaster's Report, added to the Headgate and Weir Resolution."

Headgates and Weirs

"All control devices and measuring devices shall be in good working order before water can be demanded and delivered. The Watermaster shall not deliver any water unless such devices are in good working order."

"All headgate systems that have return flow capability or a bypass channel for the water to return to Medicine Lodge must have a weir installed and functioning before water will be delivered."

Collection of Water Assessments

"No ditch, canal, or other water user shall have the right to demand and receive water until full payment due is paid. Payment shall become due April 1, 2014, and shall become delinquent May 1, 2014, and if not paid by May 1, 2014, the payment shall bear interest from May 1, 2014, at the rate of eight percent (8%) per annum.

The Watermaster shall not deliver any water until full payment due is paid."

Watermaster Term of Service

"The Watermaster shall be elected for a term of one full year. The purpose is so the Watermaster can serve in the legal capacity to do official business for the district in the event of emergencies, legislative actions, hearings, disputes or other water related or job related activities.

The Watermaster cannot be required to make water deliveries before April 1, or after November 1, (the normal irrigation season) unless an emergency exists. The Watermaster shall not be paid before April 1, or after November 1 from water district budgeted regular funds."

Pumping from Creek

"Prohibit any pumping directly from Medicine Lodge Creek as per the motion adopted in 1980, which read as follows: "That no pumping be allowed from Medicine Lodge Creek or its tributaries, without first diverting and measuring water into a private pond or sump, to eliminate any interference with regulation of stream waters."

Calling the Deputy Watermaster to Duty

"The Deputy Watermaster shall be called to duty by the Watermaster for the remainder of the season at the request of three water users whose signatures shall authorize said action."

Deputy Term of Service

"The Deputy Watermaster shall be called to duty on May 1 to measure, record and regulate waters of Medicine Lodge Creek."

Pooling Agreement

"Be it resolved that the water users of Medicine Lodge Creek unanimously agree and direct the Watermaster to continue the practice of water right exchanges, which has been practiced since the formation of the stipulation and agreement dated March 2, 1954. Such practices shall include pooling of waters, rented waters, and exchanges beneficial to the users as a whole. The Watermaster is further directed not to deliver the above mentioned waters to a downstream user, until that water delivery amount (c.f.s.) is assessed a bed loss value to provide that no injury to an existing water right would occur. These losses should be assessed according to the average of U.S.G.S. bed losses measurements.

We further resolve that delivery of the above waters cannot be demanded prior to May 1, unless excess water exits in the stream."

ADOPTING RESOLUTIONS:

Garth Ashcraft moved that all resolutions be adopted with the addition made to Headgates and Weirs. Kevin Small seconded the motion. Resolutions passed.

APPOINTMENT OF ADVISORY COMMITTEE:

Chairman Tod Shenton appointed the following Lynn Hoggan, Rhett Jacobs, Garth Ashcraft, Brock Egan and himself as the Advisory Committee.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Garth Ashcraft made a motion to have a letter of declaration of drought sent to the Clark County Commission. Brock seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Garth Ashcraft questioned if the declaration of drought letter could be used when applying for prevented planting insurance.

Brock Egan questioned the amount of water and the amount of time water could be stored. Watermaster Greg Shenton responded that he thought the water could only be stored up to 24 hours without a storage permit but will investigate this issue further. Due to continuous power outages in the past season substantial amounts of water have bypassed points of diversion and were unable to be utilized.

Deputy Watermaster, Brett Murdock, answered questions on the progress of Marlowe Goble's proposed water transfer. Brett reported that a one year extension has been filed on this transfer.

Kevin Small made a motion to put a bounty on beaver on Medicine Lodge and its tributaries, by approved individuals or waterusers for the amount of \$25.00 per beaver. Brock Egan seconded the motion. Motion passed

MEETING TIME

Garth Ashcraft moved that next year's meeting is held on Tuesday, March 10, 2015 at 3:00 p.m., at the Clark County Annex Bldg. in Dubois, Idaho. Lynn Hoggan seconded the motion. Motion passed.

ADJOURNMENT

Brock Egan moved to adjourn the meeting. The meeting adjourned at $4:18\ p.m.$
