WATER DISTRICT 74-C MARCH 10, 2014

Meeting called to order by Chairman Boyd Stokes.

Attendance: Boyd Stokes, Dean Stokes Dale Jolly, Water Master Jerry Elzinga, Mike Kossler, Daniel Bertram, Allan Brandbarry, Quinton Snook.

2013 Minutes were read and approved. Dean made a motion for approval and Dale 2nd.

2013 Financial report was read and approved. Dean made motion and Dale 2nd. There is \$268.06 in the checking as of 12-31-2013.

Old Business: Prehearing with IDWR on Melinda Tracy water application. Application was denied. State insurance fund application put in and federal tax ID number was submitted and complete.

New Business: Melinda Tracy has withdrawn her application (Permit #74-15889) for irrigation and stock water rights out of Bohannon Creek because her application was denied. She has applied for ground water rights for irrigation and stock water from their domestic well. Idaho Fish and Game, IDWR Resource Board and Bohannon Creek 74C have written letters to drop their protest because the Tracy application was denied.

Eagle Valley Ranch (EVR) has asked IDWR and Soil Water Conservation District and Model Watershed to do a study of flows from East Fork of Bohannon Creek and West Wimpy to better understand what the flows are for summer irrigation. Daniel Bertram, coordinator for Model Water Shed Program will discuss the reasons for the study at this meeting.

Election of officers and Water Master: Dale motioned to retain all officers in the same positions including Water Master.. Dean seconded. Motion passed.

Water District Budget 2014: Water Master set the budget for \$1700.00 for 2014. \$300.00 will be for workman's comp insurance and 1400.00 for salary for Water Master.

Other Business: Daniel Bertram gave report on flow measurements for East Fork Bohannon Creek and West Wimpy. Eagle Valley Ranch requested the study. The study is to get a measure of the actual water that is coming down both streams at various times of the year to see if there is extra water picked up from springs or if we are losing water through evaporation and seepage. He will measure at four points on Bohannon Creek and any where water is diverted out of the creek.

Meeting was adjourned at 3:30 p.m. Next meeting is March 9, 2015.

Complete this proposed budget report form as follows:

- 1) Enter water right holder name, corresponding IDWR water right number or numbers, and corresponding diversion name and/or remarks on page 2;
- seasons on page 3. You have the option of using at least the past two seasons or up to five seasons for averaging. You also have the option of using last year's delivery or one year's delivery as a basis of determining assessments for the next season. Enter deliveries as total 24-hour second feet. Total 24-hour second feet is a flow rate expressed in terms of one 2) If you wish to estimate next season's assessments based on the average delivery of past seasons, then enter the actual water deliveries to each user for the past two to five day or 24 hours. For example, a continuous diversion of 2 cfs over 20 days would equal 40 24-hour second feet.
- 3) If using the averaging method, enter the average delivery for past seasons in column 6 of page 3. If you are not averaging, then enter each user's delivery from last year in column 5 and skip column 6.
- 4) In the work space provided at the top of this page, enter next year's proposed watermaster salary, secretary and/or staff salaries, and expenses. You may use the past season costs and expenses, or average past seasons' costs and expenses as an aid in determining next year's budget. A more detailed listing or itemization of expenses and salaries can be attached to this form.
- 5) Divide the total proposed budget amount for next year by the total past season delivery (total of column 5, page 3) or average past seasons deliveries (total of column 6, page 3) to obtain a unit cost factor.
- 6) Under column 7, page 3, multiply the unit cost factor by each user's past season or average past seasons deliveries to obtain the estimated billing for the next year.
- 7) Use column 8, page 3, to enter the adjusted billing amount if the district wishes to carryover debits and credits from the previous season. (Refer to the last watermaster report. If a user had a credit, subtract that credit from his or her estimated billing in column 7 of this report, and enter the difference or adjusted amount in column 8. If a user had a debit, then add that debit to his or her billing amount shown in column 7 and show as adjusted billing in column 8.
- 8) Sign the report and retain to present to the water users at the next annual meeting for the water district.
