March 4, 2014**

Called to order at 7:04 P.M.

Members present Wendell Marley, Cecil Armstrong, Brian Capell, Anna Capell, Bruce Wheatley, Theron Toler, Arron Stephens, Sheldon Hatley and Derald Armstrong

Floor open to elect new officers: after discussion Bruce Wheatley made motion to keep same officers as last year. Seconded by Theron Toler Motion Passed

Officers for 2014 President Sheldon Hatley, Vice President Wendell Marley, Secretary Derald Armstrong

Minutes of the 2013 meeting were read. Brian Capell made motion to accept. Seconded by Wendell Marley. Motion Passed

Derald gave the finance report.

Garden Creek Irrigation Company is to take care of any up keep issues on the main and lateral ditches. GCIC to start the billing on the assessments on the water rights. Water District to continue billing for prior year usage. Water District hires and pays the water master as well as Workers Compensation.

April 1st is the beginning of the water year.

Brian made motion to continue to pool all water and keep on a rotating basis to insure beneficial use. Seconded by Wendell.

Motion passed.

Discussion was opened for water master compensation. Wendell made motion to compensate the water master at \$6.00 per stream or a minimum of \$14.00 per day. Seconded by Brian. Motion passed.

Discussion was opened for water master for 2014. Wendell did a good job last year. Brian made motion to hire Wendell as water master. Seconded by Theron Motion passed Wendell accepted.

We discussed the water district usage fee per stream. Brian made motion to continue to charge \$8.00 per stream. Seconded by Theron Motion passed.

Advisory Committee: Brian made motion that the advisory committee stay the same, which are the elected officers and the water master. Seconded by Bruce. Motion Passed

Aaron Stephens had questions on Arimo Corp. water. Upper diversion in Toler's was transferred to a lower diversion in the Arimo Ranches property. The State would have to be petitioned to see if that could be changed back.

Brian made motion to adjourn

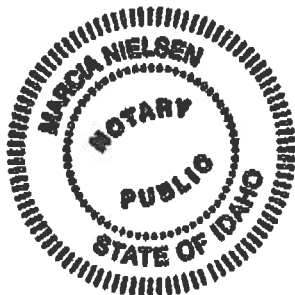
