Nick, I spoke to both Laurie Small and Greg Shenton (I was able to catch them in the same location) regarding the request to appoint a watermaster and set the budget as proposed by Greg. Greg said the budget hasn't changed in about 10 years. I advised him to contact the other two water users and see if they are okay with the suggestion of having IDWR do the appointment or if they want to reschedule the meeting. I will get back to me on the question. I also discussed with Greg the possibility of combining this district with Medicine Lodge. He said there has been some discussion about that in the past but users in Medicine Lodge may not support it because there is a lot of additional travel time and mileage from Dubois to Birch Creek that they would not want to subsidize even though they may share costs in other areas like workers comp. I suggested that we could consider two assessment rates for the two areas to address the concern about mileage and travel time. WD32-C is actually having their meeting this afternoon so Greg said he would raise the question with those users. There are about 15 to 20 users in 32-C.
