

**2018 Annual Water District Business & Budget Meeting**

March 7, 2018  
Arbon Elementry School  
Water District 29-O  
Bannock Creek Drainage

Meeting called to order – 6:00 PM

Attendees - See sign in sheet

Meeting Chairman – Vance Ward nominated Hans Hayden and Darrell Ward second, (unanimous).

Minutes taken by Jacob Anderson.

Minutes from 2017 read by Hans and Terry Schatz made motion to accept, seconded by Stu Adams (unanimous).

Advisory Committee – Vance Ward (present), Ken Campbell (present), Barry Williams (not present, had called and stated he could be reached by phone if he needed to vote or make comment), Hans Hayden (present), Ryan Cranney (not present). Motion was made by Jacob Andersen to keep the same members on committee seconded by Vance Ward (unanimous).

Water Master – Richard was nominated to remain as water master by Darrel Ward and seconded by Terry Schatz. (unanimous)

Water Assessment Fees - We have a balance of \$2,615.92 carryover in the bank. Of the \$4,223.56 collected this year in fees there is \$490.38 remaining, we are still within budget. There will be some expense before the 2018 assessment letters go out but it will be minimal.

Hans brought up an option of reducing the fees to those who have minimum fee assessment. Richard it would entail dropping the budget to match the total reduction of their assessment fee. In the 2017 season it did not require as much time for the duties of the water master, the early and late rains reduced the amount of irrigation that was done. This was decided to be looked at the 2019 budget meeting.

There are four (4) water users that did not pay their water assessment for 2017, Winn Jarvis, John and Sandra Herman, Mike and Cammie Gelles and Morris Leaman. Richard will make a special effort to contact these users.

Richard passed out the 2017 time card and expense spreadsheets and explained how he broke them down. He draws a check and double checks balances once per month. Barry and Richard review the balance sheets once a year, Hans also reviews the figures before

the annual meeting. All checks require two signatures, Barry Williams and Richard Curry. Motion to accept the timecards and expense spreadsheet made by Stu Adams and seconded by Darrel Ward. (unanimous)

Hans passed out the budget for 2018 for everyone to review and Richard discussed with them how the three (3) year average spread sheet worked. The three year average is totaled in AF then converted to CFS and applied to the budget spread sheet for the fee calculation. The 2018 assessment sheet was passed out for everyone to review. Ken Campbell moved to accept the three year average spreadsheet, the budget spreadsheet and the 2018 assessment sheet which has the set assessment fee to be billed, seconded by Darrel Ward. (unanimous)

Checking water users in the district does not require the weekly visit to some of the water users as was first set up when we developed the water district. This has enabled the water master to reduce the amount of visits to certain locations and reduce cost. However paperwork has increased. We are under our allocations by a bit and with court rulings it has triggered audits and constant requests from Fort Hall and BIA for our irrigation water usage followed by barrage of questions and comments of the report. Richard works with Tim Luke and Steve Visosky in the Boise IDWR office in response to them.

Terry Schatz brought up a question about the requirement of the flow meter valves. He has heard that the other water districts have to have meters installed in all systems this year. His question was where he is under 5 acres is he still exempt? Richard stated that that those users under five acres at this point do not have to have the meter.

There was one issue last fall. Barry's water in the Rattle Snake ditch was shut off in or about the second week of October by Willard Bradley. Richard will put a chain and lock on the head gate this year and talk with Willard. If there is a problem with water leaking and causing Willard problems then he will contact Richard and see if a solution can be worked out. Shutting the ditch down will be up to Richard. Hans said that later in the season when the grass chokes the ditch and the cattle crossing the ditch creates problems.

The next annual meeting will be set for the first Wednesday in March of 2019 at the Arbon Elementary, 6:00 PM.

Hans ask if there was any more business to discuss? There was none, Jacob made the motion to adjourn and was seconded by Terry. (unanimous)
