# 2018 Proposed Budget for Water District #34

## Proposed Resolution 1 / Passed 3-5-2018

MAR 1 9 2018 Department of Water Resources

RECEIVED

WHERE AS the Water District 34 assessments are due by April 15 of each year and whereas, some diversions either do not receive water or do not have lockable controlling works and cannot be curtailed by the Watermaster. BE IT RESOLVED that if a customer's account(s) has not been paid in full by April 15<sup>th</sup> of the year assessed, the delinquent account(s) will be referred to a credit reporting agency after October 31<sup>st</sup> of that year. Prior to referral the user will be given notice by September 15<sup>th</sup> of their delinquent account. The customer will not be again contacted by Water District 34 but instead will deal solely with the collection agency where a contingent rate and applicable fees will be applied to the unpaid assessment(s). This will warrant that all claims by the collector will be valid, legally enforceable and comply with all applicable laws.

#### **Final Assessment Determination**

It is resolved that, in accordance with Idaho Code 42-612(5), the assessment amount for each user as shown in the adopted budget shall constitute a final determination of the amount due for that year.

## Proposed Resolution 2 / Passed 3-5-2018

The committee shall be composed of ten (10) individuals. One (1) seat for a committee chairman that will serve an annual term, and nine (9) members to be nominated and elected by, and to represent users in various geographical areas in the district. In order to be nominated and represent that area the nominee must live within water district 34 and either live in that area **OR** hold the majority of his/her water rights in that area. Members term shall expire after five (5) years but may be re-elected by users at that time. If a member leaves the committee prior to the expiration of his/her term, the seat will remain empty until the next regular annual meeting or special meeting of water users, during which meeting, a replacement will be elected by the constituents for the remainder of the unexpired term.

**Annual Meeting Report** 

March 5, 2018 Mackay High School Auditorium Mackay, Idaho

#### 1.) Call Meeting to Order

VerNon Roche called the meeting to order at 2:10 p.m. and welcomed IDWR guests Dave Hoekema, Dennis Owsley, and Liz Cresto.

#### 2.) Select 2018 Annual Meeting Chairman:

VerNon Roche was nominated by Jake Johnson to serve as the Annual Meeting Chairman, seconded by Marx Hintze, Byron Perhson moved nominations cease, seconded by Kevin Donahue, motion passed unanimously, VerNon was elected to serve as the Annual Meeting Chairman.

#### 3.) Select Meeting Secretary:

Mitchell Sorensen was nominated by Jake Johnson to serve as meeting secretary, seconded by Marx Hintze, there were no other nominations, Mitchell was elected by unanimous voting.

#### 4.) Approval of 2017 Meeting Minutes:

Mitchell read the 2017 annual meeting minutes (see attached copy). Marx Hintze moved to accept the minutes as read, seconded by Ryan McAffee, voting was unanimous.

#### 5.) Snow Report:

Watermaster Lucas Yockey reported the current Sno Tel data indicates the snow pack in Basin 34 is at 92% of normal.

#### 6.) Recharge Report:

Lucas began the recharge report by stating the Big Lost River is currently flowing past the Arco Gaging Station and water is going into the Arco Desert. This indicates there still remains plenty of opportunity to improve and develop managed recharge projects within the valley. The proposed budget will address the funding needs for those sites.

#### 7.) Water Master Report:

a. Total Recharge for 2017:

b. Total Surface Water Delivered:c. Total Ground Water Delivered:

64,259 cfs <u>or</u> 127,457 AF. 151,145 cfs <u>or</u> 299,796 AF. 24,990 cfs <u>or</u> 49,567 AF.

#### 8.) Response of Big Lost Aquifer to 2017 Water Supply:

Dennis Owsley gave a slide presentation depicting a comparison of ground water levels throughout the basin between the years of 1985 and the fall of 2017. The data recovered from 25 monitoring wells showed a nearly complete recovery of aquifer levels as a result of the previous winter's abundant snow pack. The focus of the study was on the monitoring wells located in the lower parts of the valley where the greatest differences in ground water depleted and recovery levels (of more than 50 ft.) could be seen. Dennis reported ".... the valley has responded better than any other spot in the State last year" and "recharge overcame the effects of ground water pumping". He also indicated he would be taking

another series of measurements in about two weeks and expects to see evidence of continued recovery to the aquifer because the river continues to flow through the entire valley.

As part of this report, Dennis told water users the Department has a proposed Grant pending that would provide money for additional monitoring wells in the valley where data gaps currently exist. Landowners who have property along the river were encouraged to contact the Department if they are interested in providing monitoring sites. The sites would be used to monitor shallow and deep aquifer levels adjacent to the river.

#### 9.) Financial Report and Proposed Budget:

Lucas reviewed the proposed budget line by line as shown on the attached handout. The Cost Comparison was \$1.23 per cfs of usage in 2017 and \$1.31 per cfs of usage in 2018. The 2018 Cost Factor is the result of "rolling back" \$33,643.00 from the 2017 Budget into the proposed \$216,254.00 2018 Budget for an actual \$182,842.00 of new watermaster tax.

The most substantial increase in the budget is as a result of more money being requested for developing two major managed recharge sites. One in the Blaine Canal (the 1<sup>st</sup> year of a 3 phase project) and the second project is for the alternate conveyance system of water directly diverted from the river to the Moore Gravel Pit project. Each of the five recharge divisions within the basin will receive an allocation of money based upon the recharge committee's long term develop plans.

Marx Hintze moved to approve the 2018 Budget as proposed, seconded by Roger Sorensen, motion passed unanimously.

#### 10.) IDWR Water Right Accounting Review:

Liz Cresto provided an introduction to the enhanced Water Right Accounting System. The Director has made this accounting system the top priority system in the State and much effort has gone into making the program transparent and a usable tool for managing water supplies in the basin.

David Hoekema gave the presentation regarding the WR Accounting System for 2018. The system tracks surface water usage and river loss/gains by reach. The system recorded 286,000 AF flowed through the valley in 2017. This was characterized as a "Spectacular Water Winter" with snowpack ranging from 131 – 200% of normal, or 170% on average. The river shrink varied from 20 - 30 % during the season. This WRA system will also be available to water users on-line. (See Handout for details)

#### 11.) Other Business:

#### a.) Water District 34 Treasurer

Shane Rosenkrance moved Cindy Smyer be appointed as <u>WD34 Treasurer</u>, seconded by Max Bingham, voting was unanimously in favor.

#### b.) Water District 34 Watermaster

Jake Johnson moved Lucas Yockey be elected as <u>WD34 Watermaster</u>, seconded by Max Bingham, Mitchell Sorensen moved nominations cease, seconded by Roger Sorensen, voting was unanimous and Lucas was elected as Watermaster.

#### c.) Water District 34 Advisory Committee Chairman

Jake Johnson moved VerNon Roche be nominated as <u>WD34 Advisory Committee Chairman</u>, seconded by Darrell Lee McDonald, voting was unanimously in favor.

#### d.) Water District 34 Credential Committee Chairman

Shane Rosenkrance moved to retain Holly Seefried as the <u>Credential Committee Chairman</u>, seconded by Dwight Simmons, voting was unanimously in favor.

#### e.) 2019 Water District 34 Annual Meeting

Marx Hintze moved to set the next Annual Water District 34 Meeting for <u>March 4, 2019, for 2:00</u> pm. at the Butte County Middle School Auditorium, seconded by Ryan McAffee, voting was unanimously in favor.

Lucas reviewed both of the proposed resolutions with district water users and explained their need and purposes. A copy of the resolutions were included in the meeting handouts and incorporated into these minutes as such.

Chairman Roche entertained a motion to accept Resolution #1, voting was unanimously in favor.

g.) Water District 34 Advisory Committee members for (Chilly and Moore) Areas Jake Johnson nominated Shane Rosenkrance to represent the Chilly Area, seconded by Kevin Donahue, voting was unanimously in favor.
