

Minutes of the Annual Meeting

7 March 2019

Call to Order: Vice President Wendall Marley called the meeting to order at 7:02 PM. He asked that Theron (Sec/Treas) conduct the meeting.

Members Present: Wendall Marley, Theron Toler, Doug Armstrong, Price Armstrong, Kyle Wheatley, Cory Losee, Missy Losee, Scott Geraughty, Stephanie Geraughty, Bruce Edwards, and Tyson Schwartz.

Last Year's Minutes: Theron read the minutes from last year's meeting. There were no suggested changes. Wendall made the motion that the minutes be accepted as read. Missy seconded. Motion carried.

Old and New Legislation: None.

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Financial Report: Theron presented the attached financial report for the year 2018 and explained it. Wendall made a motion to accept the financial report. Kyle seconded. Motion carried.

Pool and Rotate: There is never enough water in Garden Creek for all users to use it at once, or to just use it arbitrarily. It was suggested that as in years past the water be pooled at rotated on turns or as directed by the Water Master. This method seems to provide the most beneficial use of the water. Wendall made a motion to "pool and rotate" as in years past. Doug seconded. Motion carried.

Water Master's Compensation, Adopt Budget, and Collect Revenue: Theron reviewed the historical rates and methods used. The district's main expenses are the Water Master's compensation and Worker's Compensation insurance. We have been paying the Water Master \$7/stream/day and charging the users \$8/stream/day. While this covers the Water Master's compensation and the small administrative expense, the insurance premium is not covered. It was agreed that the Water Master's compensation would be left at \$7/stream/day with a user's fee of \$8/stream/day. This allows a margin of \$1/stream/day for miscellaneous administrative expenses. The Worker's Compensation premium would be collected by spreading the cost equally among the listed authorized users of the irrigation system. This would normally amount to a flat fee of \$10.75 per user, however, some users don't pay so this causes a small deficit. So, it was decided to raise the insurance premium allocation to \$11.00 per user. Collection of these monies would be through the use of a consolidated invoice sent to all users. Theron presented and explained an example of the invoice that was used last year and suggested it be used again. Missy made a motion to accept these budget amounts and collection process. Wendall seconded. Motion carried.

Old Business: A question had arisen during the year concerning last year's billing process. All water right holders are billed an assessment per water right which goes to the Old Ditch Company for maintenance of the laterals. This assessment is set by the Old Ditch Company and is \$25 per right. Historically, this assessment had been prorated in some way to provide a "break" for the real small rights. Last year this was not done. There was a discussion on whether this proration should be reinstated. It was decided to proceed with assessing each water right the full \$25.

Election of Officers: Current officers are: Sheldon Hatley, President; Wendall Marley, Vice President; and, Theron Toler, Secretary/Treasurer. Doug made the motion to keep the officers the same. Kyle seconded. Motion carried.

Advisory Committee: The current advisory committee consists of the elected officers plus the water master, which in our case is also one of the officers. Doug made the motion to leave the advisory committee the same. Kyle seconded. Motion carried.

Election of Water Master: Doug made the motion to re-elect Wendall as the Water Master. Kyle seconded. Wendall was asked if he would accept and he said he would. Motion carried.

Call for New Business: There was none.

Adjournment: At 8:10 PM Doug made the motion to adjourn. Missy seconded. Motion carried.

WATER DISTRICT No. $29 - \beta$

It was agreed of the user's meeting that the same consolidated invoice that was used last year would be used again. It will be sent to all users and water night holders with an explanation of the charges. The collection would be based on: 1. All water right holders would be assessed a \$25 fee per right to cover expenses of maintaining the system. This fee is set by and goes to The Garden Creek Irrigation Company, Inc. 2. All users will be billed \$8/streem/day for their use. This pays the Wetermaster and admin costs. Billing for 2019 is based on 2018 useage. 3. The \$300 Worker's Coup premium would be billed equally to all water right holders. This calculater to #11:00 per each.
