Brian Jensen (2018 Chairman) conducted the election for the 2019 Chairman. Don Baldwin was nominated as the chairman by Robert Swainston, Tyler Hinckley 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion, there were no other nominations. Don Baldwin was elected chairman with everyone voting in favor.

Brian Jensen explained Lyla's job as treasurer. The Franklin County Soil and water conservation district is in charge of the books and the watermaster is responsible for collecting the assessments. He also discussed that the advisory committee can make decisions during the year for the district. James Cefalo also explained there is nothing wrong with the financials, just need a little more clarification of where the money goes.
