Dear Watermaster:

In accordance with Chapter 6, Section 42-614 of the Idaho Code, and department regulations, the Watermaster of each district is required to submit an annual report to the Department of Water Resources. You should forward a copy to the County Treasurer, if applicable. Please be certain all of the report is complete.

In accordance with Chapter 6, Section 42-615 of the Idaho Code: Proposed budget for succeeding year. Each watermaster shall, at least fourteen (14) days prior to the annual meeting of the water users of the water district, also prepare a proposed budget for the succeeding year, together with a distribution of the amount of the budget to the respective water users, using the actual deliveries for the past irrigation season or seasons, as the basis for distribution. The proposed budget and distribution shall be submitted to the water users for consideration and approval at the next annual water meeting.

This report must be forwarded to the Secretary of the last Annual Water User's Meeting of your District.

We are enclosing sufficient forms for filling out the Watermaster's Report and the Proposed Budget.

**Do not fail to send the Watermaster's Daily Record Books along with the Watermaster Report.**

FYI, I prepared Adopted Budget reports for WD29-D for years 2010 and 2011, and had the watermaster fill out and sign the standard Budget Report form. I received those signed forms today and gave them to Christine to scan and add to the annual WD29-D records. Let us know if you want copies for your files there. Please note that diversions in this district are not being measured and probably won't for some time so you should not anticipate seeing the traditional annual watermaster report forms or daily records. This may change for some diversions in future years but you should not expect to see a typical watermaster form report or delivery records for 2010 and 2011, or several more years.

Also, we did receive this spring water delivery records from Ted O'Neal of WD73. Those records have been scanned and added to the annual water district files. Again, we can send copies of those records as well if you wish. Ted still has some improvement to make on those records but the records submitted for 09/10 are better than year's past. In some cases he had lumped some diversions or water sources together and I've asked him to split those out to the individual diversions. I suspect you may still be missing adopted budget or watermaster report forms from WD73 because Maria was waiting on Ted to finish the diversion records.
