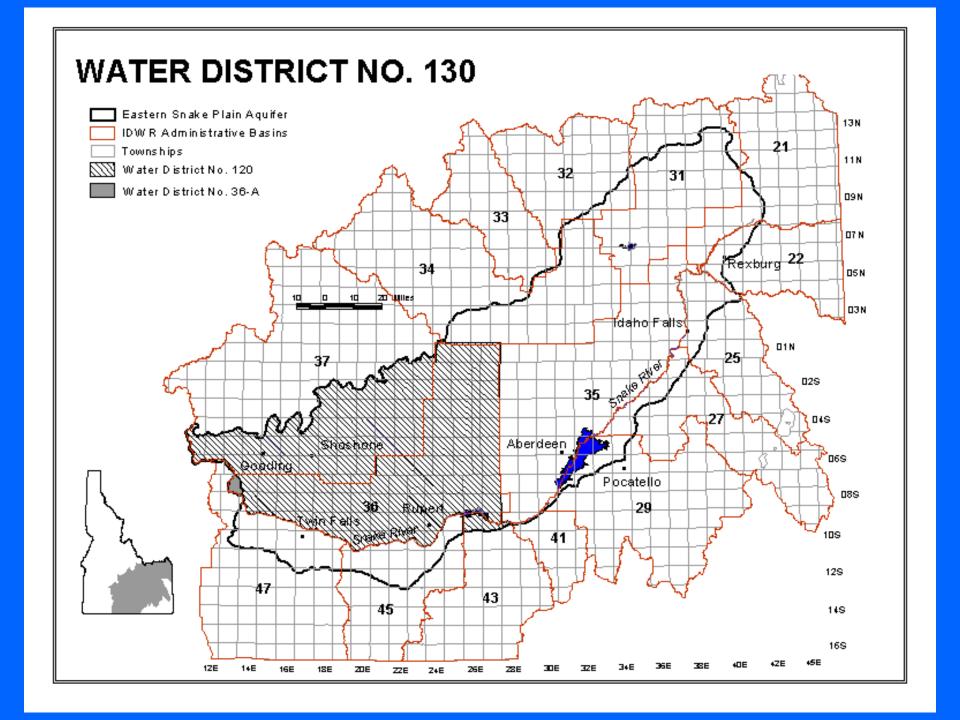
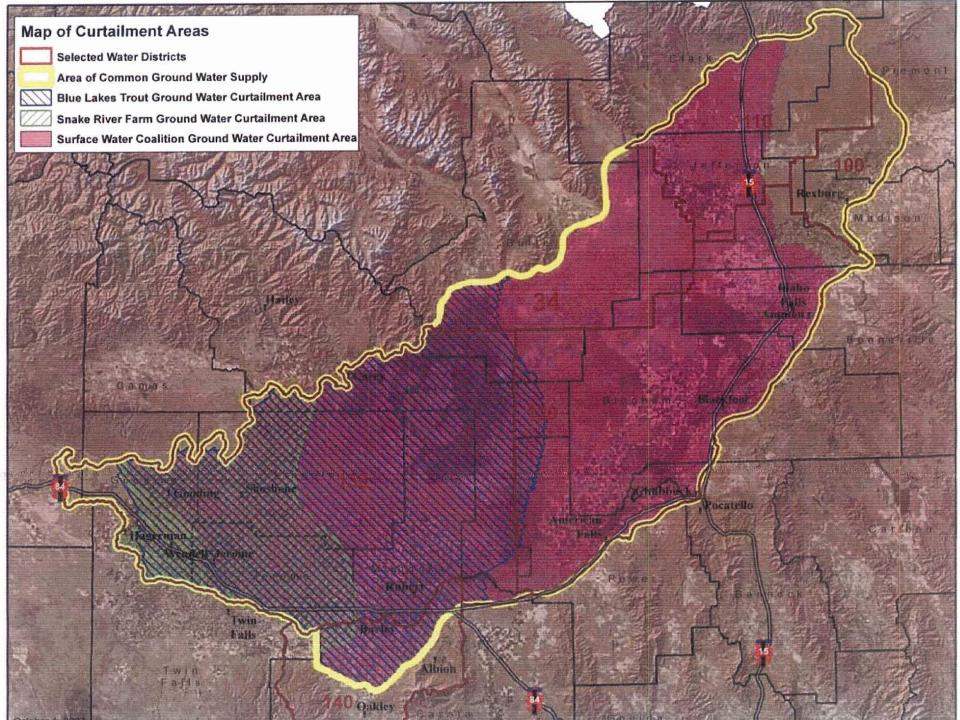

Water District 130 has adopted a minimum assessment charge of \$25. That charge will be applied to individual billings only, where the total pro-rata diversion charge for an individual water user is less than \$25. A \$25 charge will also be made to all non-reporting water users (< 0.24 cfs or ≤ 5 ac).
