



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

Re: Application for Permit No. 2-10504, Snake River Irrigation

Dear Interested Parties:

This office recently returned your applications for new irrigation water rights from the Snake River. Under the Swan Falls Agreement for trust water, a new right from the river for irrigation in your area is presumed to be not approvable due to public interest criteria and other significant factors in Idaho law and Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) Water Appropriation Rules. The applications were returned for that reason and to provide a refund of your filing fee.

In an unprecedented move, at least to my knowledge based on processing water right applications for about 25 years, a large irrigation application from the river is being processed at the request of the applicant's attorney. Grand View Mutual Canal Company (GVMC) requested Application No. 2-10504 be processed to determine if it might be approvable even under stringent trust water requirements. GVMC seeks 37 cfs (1,850 inches) for "irrigation conveyance loss." This represents approximately 50% ditch loss for that system.

IDWR agreed to process the application while the applicant prepares and submits additional information to support the application. IDWR will evaluate the additional information and any possible protests or concerns after the legal notice process is completed. Legal notices will be published in the *Owyhee Avalanche* and several other newspapers during the first two weeks of next month. The protest and comment period should end June 23, 2014.

I wanted to let you know about this so you would not think IDWR treated you unfairly in this matter. You are certainly welcome to resubmit Snake River irrigation applications to be processed. However, you would need to present evidence overcoming trust water presumptions that such applications are not approvable. I imagine this would be a difficult and most likely expensive process requiring professional technical and/or legal help.

Please let me know if you need more information in this regard.

The Idaho Department of Water Resources ("IDWR") is processing the above referenced application for additional water for irrigation/conveyance loss ("irrigation") purposes from the Snake River. Legal notices should be published during the first two weeks of next month. IDWR requests additional information in order to evaluate the application. Please respond to the following questions/concerns.

1) Signature

Water Appropriation Rules 35.03.b.xii and xiv require evidence from the applicant verifying your authority to sign the application and/or a copy of your authorized power of attorney for the applicant.

2) Large Diversion

The application exceeds 5 cfs and 200 acres of irrigation. Please respond to Water Appropriation Rules 40.05.c through h.

- For item g, please solicit written comments from the following entities:
 - Owyhee County Commissioners, Grand View Irrigation District, Snake River Irrigation District and Idaho Power (IDWR will notify Idaho Dept. of Environmental Quality, Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game and the Snake River Watermaster during the legal notice process).
 - o Please provide copies of your comment letters and any replies to this office for the application file.
- For item h regarding trust water, IDWR presumes 37 cfs diverted from the Snake River for irrigation of 2,914 acres will cause a significant reduction of more than 2 acre-feet per day at the downstream Murphy Gauge.

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3) Consumptive Use

IDWR presumes the use will be consumptive unless shown otherwise in timing and location of return flows to the Snake River.

4) Trust Water, continued

IDWR presumes the application will result in a significant reduction under Water Appropriation Rule 45.02. Therefore, please address the "... individual test for evaluating significant reduction ..." noted in that rule. The cumulative test is presumed to be met due to the limited amount of trust water approvals and does not need to be addressed.

Pursuant to Water Appropriation Rule 45.03, the application is presumed not to be in the public interest.

Some of these items might be fully applicable, partly applicable or not applicable for an existing use presumably requiring no additional construction or funding. Please note your responses to individual items to that effect wherever applicable.

Please submit the requested information within the next ninety (90) days. You may seek additional time to provide the information by making a written request to interrupt processing for up to six months. The application will be voided without a timely written reply.

Please let me know if you need anything from this office in this regard. Thank you for your attention to these matters.
