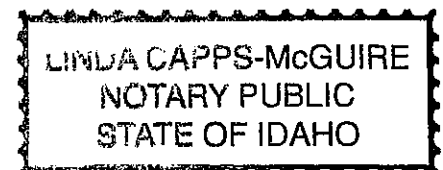

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED RENTALS FROM  
THE WATER SUPPLY BANK**

Notice is hereby given pursuant to IDAPA Rule 37.02.03.030 (Water Supply Bank Rule 30) that the Idaho Water Resource Board, P.O. BOX 83720, Boise, ID 83720-0098, filed an application on August 31, 2005 to rent Water Right Nos. 71-2091C, 71-2091D, 71-7008, 71-7009, 71-7083, 71-10665A, and 71-10665B from the Water Supply Bank for a period from August 31, 2005 through October 31, 2014. The proposed rental beginning in Blaine County would provide for the instream flow use (non-diversion) of 9.38 cubic feet per second of the waters of Beaver Creek tributary to Salmon River, Salmon River tributary to Snake River and ground water for Wild and Scenic River flow in the Salmon River.

Notice is hereby given pursuant to IDAPA Rule 37.02.03.030 (Water Supply Bank Rule 30) that the Idaho Water Resource Board, P.O. BOX 83720, Boise, ID 83720-0098, filed an application on March 1, 2007 to rent a portion of Water Right Nos. 71-64A and 71-69 from the Idaho Water Supply Bank for a period from May 1, 2007 through October 31, 2011. The proposed rental beginning in Blaine County would provide water for instream flow use (non-diversion) of 2.64 cubic feet per second of the waters of Alturas Lake Creek tributary to Salmon River for minimum stream flow in Alturas Lake Creek and for Wild and Scenic River flow in the Salmon River.

Protests may be submitted based on the criteria of Section 42-222, Idaho Code. Protests against approval must be filed with the Idaho Department of Water Resources, P.O. BOX 83720, Boise, ID 83720-0098 with a protest fee of \$25.00 for each application on or before April 7, 2008.
