I. FINDINGS OF FACT

A notice of claim was filed for the above-captioned water right pursuant to I.C. § 42-1409. The Director of the State of Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) examined the water system for this reporting area. The *Director's Report* contained a recommendation for the elements of this water right.

On March 31, 2016, Claimant Clifford Hinsz filed correspondence with the court regarding a remark that appears in the *Director's Report* which states: "Domestic use is for 1 home." The Claimant's correspondence asserts that the water right is for two homes, with a second home having been added to the property in 1967.

On July 28, 2016, the United States of America, acting through the Department of Interior, Bureau of Land Management ("BLM"), filed an objection to the *Director's Report*, asserting that the Place of Use and Point(s) of Diversion elements of the water right should be described in such a way so as to exclude federal land.

On July 11, 2017, an initial hearing on the objections was held, at which the Claimants failed to appear. A second hearing was held on September 12, 2017, and again the Claimants failed to appear. In the *Notice Resetting Initial Hearing* (filed August 16, 2017) the Claimants were notified that failure to appear at the September 12, 2017 hearing would result in a recommendation that satisfies the BLM's objection. At that hearing, counsel for the BLM described to the court that the BLM's objection would be satisfied through the inclusion of

remarks under the Point of Diversion and the Place of Use elements of the water right.

Accordingly, the attached recommendation includes those remarks. On September 19, 2017, the court received email correspondence from IDWR indicating that IDWR approves of the remarks.

As to the Claimant's assertion that the water right is for two homes rather than one, the Claimants have not produced any evidence to overcome the presumption that the *Director's Report* is correct and therefore, this Special Master does not recommend any changes regarding the Claimant's correspondence.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Therefore based on the file and record herein, IT IS RECOMMENDED that water right 94-07487 be decreed with the elements as set forth in the attached *Recommendation for Partial Decree Pursuant to I.R.C.P.* 54(b).


